

Play is a very essential part of the curriculum enabling children to learn and develop in a fun way.



Recording Learning





- Learning Diaries are an ongoing record of their learning
- Tapestry Parents to share posts from home experiences. Staff use to share learning experiences from the week. Less observations than previous, due to curriculum changes
- Assessments are made from staff interactions with the children & our professional knowledge of them


