We will be learning about the Earth's biomes and exploring how biomes and the eco systems within them can be affected.

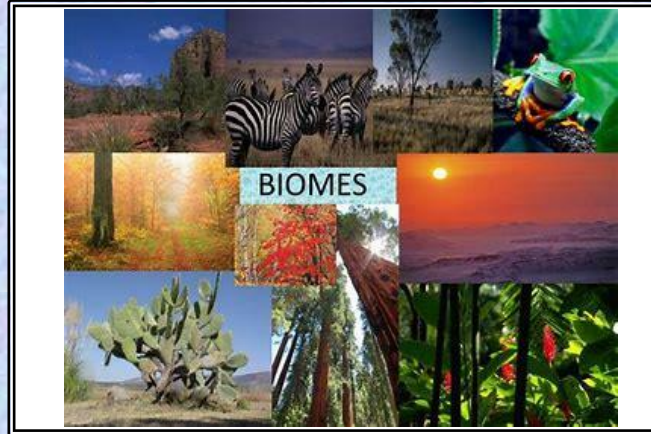
Sycamore Class Term 2 Biomes (geography focus)

Art/Music/French

Our DT project will be creating a WWII shelter.

In music, our learning will focus on the use and understanding of staff and other musical notations.

French this term will be about WWII and applying language skills to this topic.

RE/PSHE

In RE we will be learning about Christianity and our key question will be: What would Jesus do? In PSHE, our theme is, 'Celebrating Differences'. Children will explain ways in which differences can be a source of conflict or a cause for celebration and explore how we can show empathy.

English
