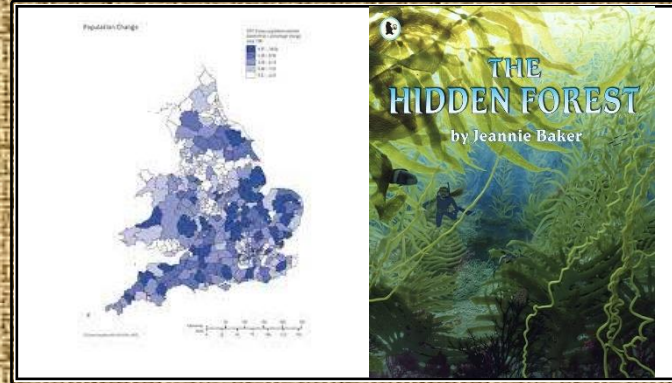

### English

Our first text this term will be, 'The Hidden Forest' by Jeannie Baker. The writing focus will be a persuasive argument about the conservation of sea kelp.

Our second focus text this term will be 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan. Writing outcomes will include letters, diary entries and an extended narrative.

### Maths

Topics this term include: ratio, algebra and decimals.

### Science

Living things and their habitats is the science topic for term 3. We will be learning about classification of microorganisms, plants and animals.

### RE/PSHE

In RE we will be learning about Islam and our key question will be: Does belief in Akhira (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives? In PSHE, our theme is, 'Dreams and Goals'. Children will explore and consider ways in which they can work together to help make the world a better place.
