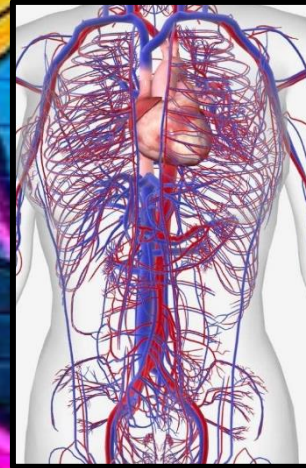

English

Our first text this term will be, 'Rainplayer' by David Wisniewski. The writing focus will be an analytical essay about the Maya.

Our second focus text this term will be, 'The Last Wild' by Piers Torday. Writing outcomes will include writing for suspense, character descriptions and formal reports.

Maths

Topics this term include: algebra; fractions, decimals and percentages.

Computing/French

Our topic in computing will continue to be 'Introducing Spreadsheets.'

For E-safety, the focus will be on cyberbullying. In French, this term will be about pets.

RE/PSHE
