History

We will be learning about the Civil Rights Movement and the Bristol Bus Boycott. Our learning will start by looking at what life was like in 1950s America. We will then consider how the Civil Rights Movement influenced the UK.

Computing

Our new topic for Computing this term is 'Internet Communication.' For E-safety, the focus will be on the theme of respect and protecting ourselves from online bullying.

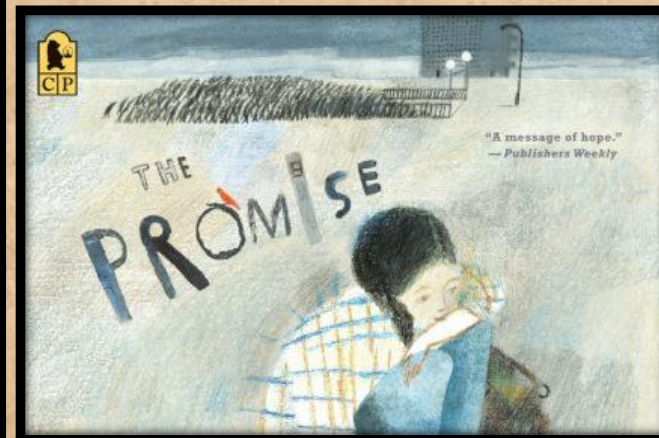

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English

After finishing our work on Rain Player and the Ancient Maya, we will focus on 'The Promise' by Nicola Davies. We will be exploring figurative language and fictional writing.

Next, we will read the book 'Windrush Child' by Benjamin Zephaniah to inspire some non-fiction writing.

Maths

Topics this term include: statistics, shape, and position and direction.

Music/French

French this term will be around vocabulary related to the home. Our music theme will be 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay' with a focus on performance.

RE/PSHE

In RE, we will continue our learning about Christianity under the theme of Salvation. Our key question will be: What difference does the resurrection make for Christians? In PSHE, our theme is, 'Relationships'.

Science/DT

In Science, we will be learning about Evolution and Inheritance. We will recognise how living things have changed over time and identify how organisms adapt to suit environments. Our DT theme is 'Fairground Rides and Games'. We will look at rotating parts and link back to circuits in science.
