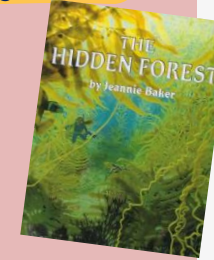

History – Early Islamic Civilisation

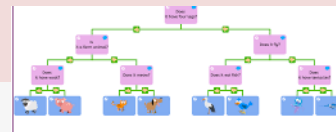
Find out as much as you can about this artefact – an oil lamp – and what it tells us about life at the time. Record facts, ideas and sketches on a poster.
