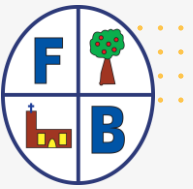


ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW

Option A

History – Seafaring

This term we are exploring how seafaring has changed over time and why. Choose a famous boat/ship from either modern day or 'long ago' (ancient Egyptian reed boat, Viking longships, Navy ships, steam powered ships, modern cruise ships etc).

Can you create a poster to share all the amazing travels that the vessel has been on? Can you share some interesting facts about it?

Option B

Science – Animals, including humans: Life cycles

This term we will be exploring life cycles and the stages of human development. You could choose an animal/insect (that experiences **metamorphosis**) and create a poster to explain their life cycle stages. You could draw pictures/take photos as they grow and change.

Option C

Art – Portraits

Can you draw a portrait of someone in your family? You could use pencil, pencil crayons, pens or paints.

You could even use fabric or junk modelling to create a sculpture of a person.
