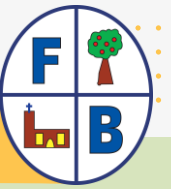


ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW

Home Learning optional projects

If you would like to, please choose one project and bring it in on the first day back after the October half term.

Option A

History- we are learning about the Stone Age.

Option B

Science- we are learning about humans and other animals.
