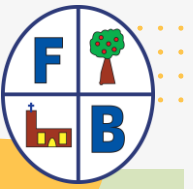


ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW Term 1 – Sycamore Class

History – World War II

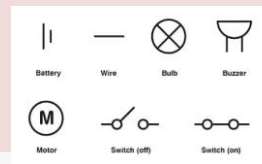
Research either Anderson shelters or Morrison shelters (your choice) and create a small scaled model of one. Be as detailed as you can and add captions!
